

## Save Energy while reducing the risk of mold and mildew

Florida home owners are often away from their homes for extended periods, especially during the summer. During the summer your home is most at risk for the development of mold and mildew. However, there are a few simple steps you can take to lessen your home's exposure.

- When your home is vacant, especially during the summer, use a programmable thermostat to run your air conditioner at 70 degrees from 2 to 6 a.m. each morning and at 88 degrees the rest of the time.
- Using dehumidifiers set to 58% relative humidity instead of air conditioning will save even more.
